<p>Maths</p>	<p>Counting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Counting 1-20 forwards and backwards ➤ Staggered counting – start at 7 - stop at 13, start at 18 - count backwards to 9 etc. ➤ What number comes just before 5? What number comes straight after 11? ➤ https://www.topmarks.co.uk/Flash.aspx?f=countingstickv4 counting stick – number activity ➤ Order numbers 1-20 mix them up and ask them to order them –use a timer and each day encourage them to beat their previous time ➤ Ordinal number: First, second, third, fourth and last. Place 5 toys in a line – question your child on who is 1st, 2nd, 3rd 4th and 5th. ➤ Children can draw a picture of 5 animals in a race and they can point out which animals comes 1st, 2nd and so on. ➤ Topmarks website ordering numbers in the correct order. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ordering-and-sequencing/caterpillar-ordering ➤ Ten bunnies counting song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Tyyh8rhwKQ8 <p>Word Problems</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ I have 2 Easter eggs, how many more do I need to have 5 Easter eggs? ➤ My friend gave me 3 flowers, you have 5 already, how many do we have altogether? ➤ Use actual objects for the children to see. ➤ I have 4 toys and my brother gave me 2 toys. How many toys do I have altogether? <p>Matching</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Give a helping hand at home by matching socks together! 😊 <p>Number Formation - 0 to 5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 1: start at the top and down we run, that's the way we make a 1 ➤ 2: around and back on the railroad track ...2...2... ➤ 3: around the tree around the tree, that's the way we make a 3 ➤ 4: down and over and down some more, that's the way we make a 4 ➤ 5: down and around and a hat on high, that's the way we make a 5

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 0: around and round and round we go, when we get home we have a 0! ➤ http://www.communication4all.co.uk/Numeracy/Number%20Formation%20Rhyme%20Cards.pdf ➤ Use chalk outside and encourage the children to make their own number line. SESE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Easter Traditions – Story of Easter, discuss how we celebrate Easter. https://www.twinkl.ie/resource/the-easter-journal-easter-traditions-powerpoint-t-or-1314 ➤ School from long ago. Children ask Mummy/Daddy about school long ago. Children could also Facetime grandparents to interview them about what school was like for them years ago. Sample Questions: Did you get much homework? How many children were in your class? What was your favourite subject? If you got into trouble, what would happen? How has school changed since you were there? ➤ Effects of heat. Investigate how heat can melt chocolate. Bake some Easter baskets with chocolate, cornflakes and mini eggs.
