Literacy

Reading:

- Click on Stage 2 and scroll across to 'A Surprise for Feena'.
- Continue reading 2-3 pages per day.
- If completed, pick any book your child likes; spend 10 minutes reading aloud and 10 minutes DEAR time.

Novel Work

Children have already picked a novel of their own choosing to read over the next few weeks. This week's tasks:

- Choose your favourite and least favourite characters from your novel and complete a character profile. These include names, descriptions, what they do, their likes and dislikes.
- Draw a picture of what they think the characters looks like.

Creative Writing

Crazy Inventions


- You are an inventor who has created a crazy invention. Describe what you have created,
 what it looks like and what it does. Will you be rich and famous? How will the world use it?
- Draw a picture of your invention.

Sound of the Week

- "are" making the /air/ sound, e.g. hare, care, share etc.
 - Come up with a list of words that contain this sound.
 - Practise putting these words into sentences.
 - Dictation based on this week's sound.

Grammar

- This week's grammar topic focuses on 'prefixes'.
- Prefixes are words that go in front of other words. The most useful ones are un / dis / mis and im.
 For example, unpacked, impossible, dislike, and misunderstood.

Maths

Some additional activities based on capacity:

- Find an object that holds 1 litre. Now find as many objects as you can that hold less than 1 litre and more than 1 litre around the house.
- Order the objects above starting with what holds the least to the most.
- Make a list of the litres and millilitres on items around the house.
- Estimate how many yoghurt cartons/egg cups/mugs would fill a litre bottle.
