If you wish, continue to catch up on any pages not filled in, in your copy.</li><li>• Reminders: Capital letters and full stops. Correct letter formation. Tripod pencil grip.</li></ul> <p><b>Phonics:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continue to revise all letter names, sounds and digraphs (ai, oa, ie, ee, or, ng, oo, ch, sh, th, qu, ou, oi, ue, er, ar)</li><li>• New Jolly Phonics Rule- The letters 'oy' sometimes say the 'oi' sound. For roll no. use code: Prim20</b></p> <p><b>Planet Maths: Page 126,127 and 128</b></p> <p><u>Weight/Addition</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Compare the weights of objects that differ in size and shape.</li> <li>• Select and use appropriate non-standard units to measure weight.</li> <li>• Estimate and measure weight in non-standard units, check using balance (you can make a homemade balance if you wish) <b>Teacher will email a sample.</b></li> <li>• Record estimates and actual measurements. Compare your results.</li> <li>• Add 3 numerals to totals of 10.</li> </ul> <p><u>Counting</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Counting forwards to 100 in 1s and 10s and 5s</li> <li>• Counting backwards from 60 to 1</li> <li>• Counting forwards in 2s to 70 (odd numbers/even numbers)</li> <li>• Revising correct number formation (0-10)</li> <li>• Skip counting forwards/backwards on a number line to 20. e.g. Start on 11 and go on 4 jumps. Start on 17 and go back 6 jumps etc.</li> </ul>
