Literacy	<p>Reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue to spend 10 minutes reading aloud and 10 minutes DEAR time. <p>Creative writing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Alien.• Write a story about the time you were in outer space and you met an alien.• What did they look like? Were they friendly/scary? Did they help you? How did they speak? How did they travel around?
