



## Whitebeam

The leaves of the Whitebeam are green on top, but are soft and silvery underneath.

The leaves are oval shaped with toothed edges.

The flowers that grow on it in summer are white, have 5 petals and grow in clusters.

The flowers develop into bright red berries in Autumn.

The wood of the Whitebeam is strong and hard, making it useful for building chairs and tables.

Caterpillars and moths love to eat its leaves.
